- Writings will be judged on originality, neatness, punctuation, and grammar.
- Your FULL name and telephone # must be written on top of the first page.
- An official entry form must be attached to each submission.
- There will be up to seven winners: A Grand Prize winner and up to three winners for grades 7-8 and up to three winners for grades 9-12.
- Winners will be notified by email or phone and then recognized at a special reception, open to the public, on Monday, October 30 at 6:30 p.m. in the Cedar Room.
- Any work submitted may be published on the Santa Clara City Library's webpage, other online library outlets, and/or in local newspapers. Submissions will NOT be returned.
- Entries may be edited and the Library reserves the right to publish the edited version.
