

2014 ARTIST APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

The thirty fourth annual Santa Clara Art and Wine Festival, sponsored by the City of Santa Clara, features 175 artist and crafts persons, tantalizing food, local wine and live entertainment. The festival is held in Santa Clara's beautiful Central Park among winding paths and trailing wisteria vines. The festival has drawn more than 50,000 people each year. Proceeds from the festival benefit various local charities.

DATES: Saturday and Sunday, September 13 and 14, 2014

TIME: Saturday, 10:00 a.m.-6:00 p.m. and Sunday, 10:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m.

LOCATION: Santa Clara's Central Park (Kiely Boulevard between Homestead Road and Benton Street)

BOOTH SIZE: Each space is approximately 10' by 12'. There will be 175 artist booths and 32 food booths located on the walkways throughout the park. Sellers must provide their own booth, tables and chairs. Electricity is not available. The festival staff will determine booth locations approximately three weeks prior to the festival.

COST: Jury fee: \$20.00 per category (must be included with application, are non-refundable)
Booth Fee: \$255.00 per space (to be paid upon acceptance to the festival)
Checks are payable to the "City of Santa Clara"

ELIGIBILITY: The festival is open to artists and craftpersons selling original, handmade art and crafts. We strive for diversity in both price range and medium. No food products, imports, kits or mass-produced items will be considered. No dealers or representatives should apply. Booths will be checked during the festival to ensure that only juried work is sold. Selection is based on originality, quality, presentation and number of exhibitors allotted to each category. The producers of the festival will make final acceptance or rejection decision. Participation in previous festivals does not guarantee acceptance in this year's festival.

APPLICATION: Fill out the application form completely. *Incomplete applications will not be processed.* List and describe work on application form. Send 5 photographs of your work showing variety and quality, one photograph of your booth, and photos of three stages of production in your workshop/studio (9 photographs total). All photographs are mandatory. Do not send slides or photographic CD's. Music vendors must send a sample of music. If you have participated in the festival in the past, you may request the same space on the application form on the special needs and requests line (this does not guarantee placement). Persons desiring to share a booth or display work in more than one medium should submit 5 photographs of each medium and separate applications. DEADLINE: Applications will be juried after March 1 and June 1, 2014, depending on date of receipt. Artists will be notified of acceptance or rejection within 30 days of being juried. We maintain a small waiting list for each category; applicants placed on the waiting list will be notified of such action.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: All work must be hand-carted to the artist booth from the parking lot. NO VEHICLES will be allowed in the park. Artists will be allowed to set up beginning Friday, September 12 during specific times. *No pets are allowed in the artists booths or at the festival.* Free parking, for one vehicle, will be provided to vendors. Overnight parking for vendors is provided with permission. Overnight security is provided in the park on Friday and Saturday. Extensive publicity and wide community support ensure the success of this event. Publicity includes community mailings, local newspaper articles, television and radio announcements, banners, signs, posters and a listing on the City of Santa Clara web site.
