

VOLUNTARY TOW PROGRAM for Santa Clara Residents

The City of Santa Clara provides residents with the <u>free</u> removal and disposal of unwanted vehicles. In order to qualify for this service, the following requirements must be met:

- The program is only available to residents of the city. The citizen must provide proper identification showing residency.
- The vehicle to be removed must be within the Santa Clara city limits.
- The citizen must provide a title of ownership or other legal proof indicating sole ownership of the vehicle to be removed.
- The program applies to passenger vehicles; including sport utility vehicles, vans and pick-up trucks. RV's, motor homes, boats and oversized vehicles will not be accepted.
- One vehicle towed per address or resident within 12 months.
- The owner agrees to sign documents releasing all interest in the vehicle.
- The owner releases the vehicle with the understanding that the vehicle will be dismantled.
- The owner understands that they are responsible for any previous parking violations, penalties and or fees related to that vehicle.

The Santa Clara Police Permits Unit will make arrangements with a contracted tow company for the removal of the vehicle and process all DMV paperwork.
